Monday 28th August
Commenced with moderate
winds and a heavy swell from
the S.W. middle part wind
from the S increased to a gale
later part heavy gales and
cloudy weather Lat 40° 00' N

Tuesday 29th
Begins with fresh gales from
N.W. and cloudy weather mid
part, with much the same
at 8 A.M. more moderate hauled
to N. Lat 40° 00' N

Wednesday 30th
Commenced with fresh winds
from N.W. at 4 quite moderate
set the main topsail mid
part, wind hauled to N.W. at 6
set the fore sail ends with
fresh gales Lat 38° 25' N Long 21° 36' W

Thursday 31st
Begins with fresh gales from
N.W. raised the fore sail
at 8 P.M. specially took in the fore
sail and main topsail mid part and
later part heavy gales
Lat 37° 00' N

Friday 1st September
Begins with heavy gales from the
N.W. and hail squalls ship heading
North at 8 P.M. split the fore top
mast, stay sail mid part, squally
at 7 more moderate at 8, the
stay sail to repair
Lat 37° 30' N Long 20° 45' W

Saturday 2nd Sept
Commenced with strong
gales and heavy sea from N.W.
middle and latter parts much
the same Lat 36° 30' N Long 20° 45' W

on a whaling voyage

Sunday 3rd September
Begins with fresh winds and
a heavy swell from N.W. at 8 P.M.
set the main topsail and fore
sail at 8 P.M. wind light
middle part, with fresh from S.W.
and rainy latter part fresh gales
Lat 36° 00' N

Monday 4th
Strong gales from N.W. at 6
blowing very heavy mid part
took in the main topsail
and with heavy gales Lat 36° 40' N

Tuesday 5th
Begins with heavy gales and
cloudy mid part, more mod-
erate set the main topsail and fore sail
latter part fresh winds and thick
Lat 36° 00' N

Wednesday 6th
Commenced with fresh winds
and cloudy weather at 8 P.M. saw
a barque blowing from N.W. wind light
at 8 P.M. spoke Wangle Hope, gunnell
of New Bedford four months out, no
oil, with fresh gales at 8 at 10 P.M.
on board the Hope ends with thick
fog and rain Lat 36° 00' N

Thursday 7th
Begins with fresh winds from
N.W. at 8 P.M. shifted to N.W. at 8
took in the fore sail at 8 P.M.
used to a gale mid part, more
moderate latter part, light winds
and thick and rainy Lat 36° 00' N

Friday 8th
Commenced with light winds
from N.W. at 8 P.M. at 8 P.M. the fore
topsail at dark took in sail and
now too heading S.P. mid part
moderate and cloudy at 6 made
sail latter part squally raised the
topsails
make
