Saturday 30th
 415 Begins with light winds
 from the N. and at 2 P.M. spoke
 ship Georgia of London
 350 tons at 4 fresh winds started
 red sail at dark took in
 sail for the night
 Middle part fresh gales from N.
 at 5 made sail at 8 fresh
 gales took in sail Lat 35.10 Long 145.25

Sunday 1st October
 416 Begins with fresh gales from
 the N. E. at 5 P.M. more moderate
 Middle part fresh gales from N.
 at 8 more ship to N. W. at 8 set
 the fore gail and kept off N.
 Lat 36.10 Long 146.12

Monday 2nd
 417 Commenced with light winds
 and a heavy swell from S. set
 the fore topsail at dark took in
 sail Middle part fresh winds
 at 5 made sail at 9 took saw
 a ship steering N. saw five backs
 ends with fresh winds and
 squalls Lat 34.58 S Long 148.22

Tuesday 3rd
 418 Begins with fresh winds from
 N. at dark took in sail and bent
 two heading N. S. W. mid part
 made at 5 made sail at 8 lowered
 for two right whales could not
 get past but chased the same ones
 Lat 34.21 S

Wednesday 4th October
 419 Commenced with light winds
 from S. E. at 4 P.M. lowered for
 a whale could not get past at
 dark more ship at dark took in
 sail mid part moderate
 at 5 made sail at 9 took saw
 saw whales going quick
 did not lower Duff with light
 winds from S. E. Lat 34.54 S Long 149.29

Thursday 5th
 420 Commenced with light winds
 from S. E. and fine weather
 course N. W. at 4 P.M. saw a barque
 boiling at dark took in sail for
 the night mid part moder-
 ate and cloudy at 5 made sail
 saw a whale going quick
 ends with fresh winds from
 E Lat 34.38 S

Friday 6th
 421 Begins with fresh winds
 and clear weather at 1 P.M.
 spoke barque Caravelier of Salem
 two sperm and one right whale
 at 6 took in sail mid part
 fresh gales and raining latter
 part strong gales from N. W.

Saturday 7th
 422 Begins with fresh gales from
 N. W. middle part moderate
 at 5 made sail ship heading
 N. E. latter part light winds
 from N. E. and fine weather
 Lat 35.08 S Long 150.22

Sunday 8th
 423 Begins with light winds
 from N. E. at 1 P.M. thick fog
 at dark took in sail heading
 N. E. wind and latter part
 thick and raining ship heading
 W. N. W. Lat 36.06 S
