

Monday 9th October
Commenced with light
winds and thick rainy weather
at 4 PM took in sail for
the night, made part, clear
at 8 made sail at 9 PM double
reefed the topsails at 11 clear and
pleasant made sail
Lat 34° 55' Long 18° 55' W

Tuesday 10th
Begins with fresh winds
and fine weather ship head
ing N. Middle part light winds
from N. made sail at 8
suddenly with rain took in sail
latter part strong gales from S
Lat 34° 35' Long 19° 00' W

Wednesday 11th
Commenced with fresh
gales from S at 4 noon made
middle part light breezes
made sail at 6 wind
the reef out Lat 34° 00' Long 19° 00' W

Thursday 12th
Begins with fresh winds from
W. saw a school of blackfish
took one to the ship at 3 PM
spoke ship Joseph Woodwell
Stuart of Fairhaven two sperm
and one right whale at dusk
with in some Mid and latter
part strong gales with a heavy
sea from W. Lat 34° 00' Long 19° 00' W

Friday 13th
Begins with heavy gales from
W. at 8 PM ship gave a lee buck
and drove the harbour port
took off half the main boat
with crew craft in mid and
latter part strong gales with
a very heavy sea
Lat 35° 00' Long 19° 00' W

Saturday 14th
Begins with heavy gales from
W. at 8 PM middle part from moderate
at the fore sail latter part
wind increased reefed the fore
sail employed in repairing
stud hole Lat 35° 30' Long 19° 00' W

Sunday 15th
Commenced with strong
gales from W. ship off the
the beam mid and latter
part wind and weather
much the same
Lat 36° 11' Long 19° 00' W

Monday 16th
Begins with strong gales
from W. and cloudy
middle and latter part
no alteration Lat 37° 00' Long 19° 00' W

Tuesday 17th
Commenced with heavy gales
from W. and cloudy weather
middle part wind shifted
to S. at 3 made sail
latter part light winds
and fine weather
Lat 37° 00' Long 19° 00' W

Wednesday 18th
Begins with light breezes
and fine weather at dusk
double reefed the topsails ship
heading W. at 10 middle part
light wind from W. and rain
made sail latter part fresh
winds and very rough sea
Lat 37° 00' Long 19° 00' W

Thursday 19th
Begins with strong winds
from S. ship the fib and took
in sail at 8 PM made ship
led to S. and flew a gale
mid part more moderate
at 5 made sail latter part
light winds
Lat 36° 44' Long 20° 00' W
