

445 Monday 30th October
Begins with fresh winds
and fair weather set the
jag sail, passed the
ships steering S.
Mid fresh fresh winds from
W at 4 made sail, latter part
light winds Lat 33° 57' Long 121° 51'

446 Tuesday 31st
Begins with light winds
from S and pleasant
weather, at dark took in
sail mid fresh light winds
from N at 4 made sail, at 10
kept off 1st winds with fresh
winds and fair weather
Lat 33° 08'

447 Wednesday 1st November
Begins with fresh winds
from N at 4 took in sail
fresh gales and raining
at 10 the moderate winds
from W made sail, at
9 lowered for a right whale
could not get fast, ends
with light winds and fine
weather Lat 34° 06' Long 121° 35'

448 Thursday 2nd
Commences with light
winds from W at 10
saw sperm whales behind
the going very quick, could
not get up with them
at 10 saw a right whale
took in sail four ships
in sight on boiling
mid fresh moderate made
sail later fresh fresh
winds and fine weather
spoke Barque Jason of N
London 3 whales
Lat 34° 37' Long 121° 43'

449 Friday 3rd
Begins with fresh winds
from N at 4 took in sail
at dark took in sail for the night
middle part fresh winds
and stayed at 4 made sail
and kept off 1st winds with fresh
winds and a big steering S E
Lat 34° 44' Long 121° 38'

450 Saturday 4th
Commences with fresh
winds from N at 4 chased
a whale at dark took in
sail heading W at 10 sail in
sight mid fresh fresh winds
and stayed at 6 made sail
later fresh fresh winds
and stayed reefed the top
sails this day saw 14 ships
two boiling Lat 35° 10' Long 121° 54'

451 Sunday 5th
Begins with fresh winds
and fair weather at 4
the passed a ship, stayed
a white signal with letter
G at dark took in sail
heading W at 10
middle fresh fresh winds
and stayed at 4 made sail
later fresh strong winds
reefed the top sails two sail
in sight Lat 35° 55' Long 122° 04'

452 Monday 6th
Commences with fresh winds
from N W and squally at
10 the saw the sail from the
mast head took in sail
middle and later part
strong winds from N W
several sail in sight
steering various courses
Lat 35° 17' Long 122° 02'
