Commences with light wind
from SE and fine weather
at 6 AM in sail for the
night, middle and latter
part fresh winds and cloudy
Lat 33°40' Long 22°36'

Sunday 17th
Begins with fresh winds
from SE and fine weather
saw fin back at 4 PM
in sail ship heading SE
middle and latter part
fresh gales from SE
Lat 33°50' Long 22°32'

Monday 18th
Commences with fresh
winds from SE and cloudy
at 6 AM in sail ship
American, Grinnell of Warren
saw whales middle and latter
part fresh winds and
rainy Lat 33°40'

Tuesday 19th
Begins with fresh
winds and cloudy
middle part moderate and
made sail latter part
calm Lat 33°34' Long 22°50'

Wednesday 20th
Commences with light
winds from SE and fine
weather at 6 AM in
sail for the night
middle part light winds
from SE and made sail
and kept off SE a sail
astern saw fin back
Lat 32°44' Long 22°40'
