Begins with fresh wind
from E and pleasant
all day but during night
at 6 P.M. the foremast
studding sail mid and lower
part fresh winds and squally
Lat 18° 40' Long 141° 50'

559 Wednesday 21st
Commences with fresh winds
and fine weather mid and
lower part strong winds and
squally Lat 17° 14' Long 140° 50'

560 Thursday 22nd
Begins with fresh breeze
from East course altered
mid and lower part fresh
winds and squally
Lat 16° 20' Long 139° 30'

561 Friday 23rd
Commences with light
winds from E employed
in picking up the after
hold mid and lower part
no alteration
Lat 14° 12' Long 138° 18'

562 Saturday 24th
Begins with light winds
from E and fine weather
saw a sail off the lee beam
right and lower part
light winds and pleasant
Lat 12° 39' Long 137° 44'

563 Sunday 25th
Commences with light
winds and pleasant
mid part squally lower
part light winds and
fine weather
Lat 10° 15' Long 137° 00'

564 Monday 26th
Begins with light breeze
from E and fine weather
the sails lowered and took
two to the ship
mid part light winds
and cloudy at 6 P.M.
commenced
cutting at 10 finished and
made sail Lat 10° 40' Long 136° 00'

565 Tuesday 27th
Begins with light winds
from E and pleasant
commenced putting up
3 square top the top all
at 10 P.M. made sail
saw fine weather
made sail Lat 9° 50' Long 135° 00'

566 Wednesday 28th
Commences with light
winds and pleasant
a ship astern mid part
moderate finished boiling
water part fine weather
all sail put starting at 10
Lat 8° 00' Long 134° 00'

567 Thursday 29th
Begins with fresh winds from E
and fine weather at 10
stocked the foreward anchor
and got it on the bow
mid part wind and weather
much the same at 6 P.M.
saw a ship ahead at 10
saw the land 12 miles
distant fresh winds
and fine weather
