573 Wednesday 19th
 Commences with brisk
 breeze from E and pleasant
 at 10 o'clock the fore topmast
 sail mid and later part
 fine breeze from E employed
 in working off Lab 300 Long 83° 00'

574 Thursday 20th
 Begins with fresh winds and
 pleasant weather mid part
 traced up a look in the
 studding sail ends with
 moderate breeze from E
 Lab 200 Long 83° 00'

575 Friday 21st
 Commences with light
 winds and pleasant weather
 mid part wind
 from E at 10 o'clock the fore top
 mast studding sail ends
 with light winds and fine
 weather Lab 1000 Long 81° 00'

576 Saturday 22nd
 Begins with light winds and
 pleasant weather at 11 o'clock
 with rain took in top gall
 sail mid and later
 part moderate wind from
 the E Lab 1000 Long 81° 00'

577 Sunday 23rd
