

Monday 14th March
 578 Begins with light breeze
 and fine weather. At 10 AM
 saw sperm whales towing
 stick sunk two lost, one line
 and took a whale to the ship
 and took it in and made sail
 with breeze and flying clouds
 from NE Lat 14° 18' N Long 89° 30' W

Tuesday 15th
 579 Begins with fresh wind
 and cloudy weather. At 10 AM
 the fore topmast, cloud
 in sail. The watch em-
 ployed in hoisting
 at 10 finished mid and
 latter part fresh winds
 and cloudy Lat 15° 30' N Long 90° 50' W

Wednesday 16th
 580 Commences with fresh
 winds from NE at 10 AM
 double reefed the topsails
 course NE. At 11 AM the party
 more moderate turned
 out reefs latter part strong
 winds and flying clouds
 from NE Lat 16° 00' N Long 93° 00' W

Thursday 17th
 581 Begins with strong breeze
 from NE and single reefed
 the fore and the mizzen
 topsails. Mid and latter
 part strong winds
 with a heavy sea
 Lat 17° 30' N Long 94° 00' W

Friday 18th
 582 Begins with strong breeze
 and rough, employed
 in mending sails
 mid and latter part more moderate
 latter part fresh winds
 and fine weather
 Lat 19° 00' N Long 95° 45' W

Saturday 19th
 583 Commences with fresh
 breeze and fine weather
 and part strong winds
 and squalls took in top
 gallant sails. Latter part
 strong winds rippled the top
 sails Lat 19° 00' N Long 97° 00' W

Sunday 20th
 584 Begins with strong breeze
 from E. At 10 AM the party
 mid and latter part fresh
 winds and squalls
 Lat 19° 00' N Long 99° 00' W

Monday 21st
 585 Commences with fresh breeze
 and pleasant weather mid part
 more moderate at 10 AM
 latter part strong winds and
 fine weather took a Lancer OB
 Lat 19° 00' N Long 101° 00' W

Tuesday 22nd
 586 Begins with strong winds and
 fine weather employed in mending
 masts and other jobs
 middle part strong winds and
 squalls. Latter part fresh
 breeze and fine weather
 mending the mizen topsail to
 repair Lat 19° 00' N Long 102° 00' W
 Studying Lat 16° 21' N Long 102° 00' W
 Diff. Feb. 22nd 3'
