 Begins with light wind from
 SE and pleasant weather
 middle and later part calm
 Lat 34.00 N Long 68.55 W

603 Friday 6th
 Commences with light breeze
 from SE saw a big steering
 SE at 8 heavy squalls from SE
 close reefed fore topsail furled
 main topsail fore and speaker
 at 4 noon light at 6 noon to SE
 ends with strong breeze from
 SE Lat 34.58 N Long 69.55 W

604 Saturday 7th
 Begins with fresh winds from
 SE ship under single reefed
 fore heading SE saw a big
 steering SE mid part calm
 at 8 light winds from SE
 saw a big and barque steering
 Southward latter part strong
 breeze took in topsails
 and main topsail double reefed
 fore and main topsail
 under sail Lat 35.40 N Long 71.00 W

605 Sunday 8th
