

Monday 17th August
Commences with fresh winds from
the NW and squally at 2 PM spoke
ship lookwise of Wamucke, 11 days
out middle part, fresh winds and
squally took in topgallant sails latter
part pleasant. Lat 39° 12' N Long 32° 55' W

Tuesday 18th
Begins with moderate winds from the
NW shifted stud sails at 4 took in
light sails and hauled up the courses
middle part, fresh winds from the NE
at daylight saw the Island of Flores har-
ing 8 PM 20 miles dist, latter part light
breezes sent a boat on shore

Wednesday 19th
Commences with light winds and
variable spoke schooner Laurel of Roches-
ter middle part moderate wind on
shore latter part employed in
taking on board potatoes onions &c

Thursday 20th
Light winds and pleasant at
7 AM the boat came on board
spoke NW at 9 the SW point of Flores
more East dist 10 miles middle and latter
part fine weather Lat 37° 45' N

Friday 21st
First part light winds from
the NW at 2 PM shifted to the NE
fresh squally with rain middle and
latter part thick and raining saw
a brig. Lat 35° 24' Long 31° 45' W

Saturday 22nd
Commences with thick squally
weather wind SW to NE middle part
wind hauled off latter part light
winds and pleasant
Lat 33° 48' Long 31° 36' W

Sunday 23rd August
Light winds from the SE and fine
weather middle and latter part
wind and weather much the same
Lat 32° 02' Long 31° 56' W

Monday 24th
Strong winds from the S.E. and
pleasant, much part squally mid-
dle part squally parted one of the main
topmasts, backstays Lat 29° 12' Long 32° 14' W

Tuesday 25th
Strong winds from the SE and squa-
lly from a sail steering NW at 1 PM took
in the main top gallant sail saw a barque
steering NW a ship NE latter part squally
Lat 27° 33' Long 31° 36' W

Wednesday 26th
Vizy part fresh winds and squally
double reefed the topsail middle part
moderate turned the reefs out
and set top of sails sent down the
cross Jack yard fitted it and sent it
up Lat 25° 20' Long 31° 25' W

Thursday 27th
Light winds from the East and plea-
sant steering SE by E middle part
fresh winds and squally took in the
fore top of sail Lat 22° 18' Long 30° 35' W

Friday 28th
Commences with fresh winds
from the E double reefed the fore
topsail mid part thick latter
part moderate set top of sail saw
a sail off the lee beam steering
SE Lat 20° 35' Long 29° 51' W
