mending sails Lat 13° 58' Long 16° 41'

Tuesday 29th
62 Commences with light winds from
the S.E. and fine weather all sail set
by the best advantage saw several
humpbacks Lat 15° 32' Long 18° 25'

Wednesday 30th
63 Bristly part, light winds and pleasant
and middle part, wind variable
latter part, calm, saw a humpback
Lat 16° 11' Long 20° 00'

Thursday 1st October
64 Begins with light winds from the
South employed in setting up the
rigging, middle part, calm, latter part,
light breezes saw a humpback
Lat 16° 30' Long 18° 38'

Friday 2nd
65 Commences with light winds and
variable tacked ship to the S.W. middle
part, wind S.E. latter part, fine weather
saw grampuses Lat 17° 12' Long 19° 31'

Saturday 3rd
66 Begins with light winds from the
S.E. course S.W. middle and latter part,
moderate and pleasant saw a hump
back Lat 18° 25' Long 19° 57'

Sunday 4th
67 Begins with light breezes and fine
weather saw a fin back mid part,
wind variable tacked to the S.E. latter
part, pleasant, tacked to the W.
Lat 18° 59' Long 20° 33'

Monday 5th
68 Commences with light winds from
the S.E. at 2 PM, tacked to the E. wind
S.W. at 8 tacked to the W. middle and
latter part, pleasant
Lat 19° 13' Long 23° 02'

Tuesday 6th October
69 Light winds from the S.E. and fine
weather mid part, very moderate
latter part, wind N.E. course S.W. by W.
set, stud sail. Lat 20° 55' Long 21° 42'

Wednesday 7th
70 Begins with light winds from the
N.W. and pleasant, course S.W. by W.
middle part, wind hauled shifted
studding sail, latter part, fresh wind
saw a humpback Lat 22° 38' Long 21° 22'

Thursday 8th
71 Commences with fresh winds
from the N.W. and pleasant, course
S.W. by W. mid part, squally, wind shift
ed to South took in studding sail
latter part, pleasant, saw fin back
Lat 24° 20' Long 20° 05'

Friday 9th
72 Begins with light winds from the
N.W. and pleasant, saw a humpback
and an Albatross, latter part, fine
weather employed in sending up
the cutting gear Lat 24° 55' Long 19° 26'

Saturday 10th
73 Commences with light winds from
S.W. heading S.E. aloft hauled at 10
AM tacked to the S.W. wind S.W. by
latter part, pleasant, Lat 25° 35' Long 18° 53'

Sunday 11th
74 Bristly part, light winds and fine
weather starting S.W. by the wind
mid and latter part, wind and
weather much the same, saw a
humpback Lat 27° 03' Long 19° 24'

Monday 12th
75 Commences with gentle winds
from E.S. middle part, fresh winds
from the W. and bumpy, the tide and
bent, another set, stud sail
Lat 29° 09' Long 19° 06'
