

88. Sunday 21st October
Commences with light winds from the SE and thick weather at 5 PM tacked to the SE light winds and variable squally and latter part moderate but the main sail saw fin back
Lat 35° 44' Long 6° 44' W

89. Monday 22nd
Begins with light winds from the NE and pleasant, saw fin and hump back saw 2 ships spoke the Xenophon, Handed, of Loughbour & whaler
Lat 35° 48' Long 4° 12'

90. Tuesday 23rd
First part light winds from the NE and pleasant, saw fin back saw a sail at the windward mid and latter part, pleasant, saw 2 ships
Lat 35° 37' Long 1° 55' W

91. Wednesday 24th
Begins with light winds from the NE saw several ships steering SE at dark shortened sail latter part moderate saw fin and hump back
Lat 34° 14' Long 1° 12' E

92. Thursday 25th
First part light winds from the N saw 2 whales toward the boat struck one and drew came on board one sail in sight at dark shortened sail for the night middle part moderate made sail latter part fresh winds
Lat 34° 08' Long 3° 22' E

93. Friday 26th
Commences with fresh winds from the N & at dark shortened sail one sail in sight middle part strong winds from the SE and latter part pleasant made sail latter part fresh winds took in top gallant sail
Lat 32° 28' Long 5° 13'

94. Saturday 27th October
Begins with fresh winds from the SE course & saw fin back at dark took in sail middle part moderate latter part fresh winds up went the fore top sail to repair and put another
Lat 31° 54' Long 6° 40' E

95. Sunday 28th November
Commences with fresh winds from the SE and pleasant weather saw several galleys quick to the SE chased them dark in sail middle part made sail latter part fresh winds and with a heavy swell from the SE caught 3 porpoises
Lat 31° 01' Long 6° 07'

96. Monday 29th
Begins with light winds from the SE at 2 PM tacked to the SE at dark took in sail middle part wind light made sail saw a sail latter part moderate tacked ship
Lat 31° 46' Long 6° 07'

97. Tuesday 30th
Commences with light winds from the SE saw ship in sight middle and latter part pleasant
Lat 32° 13' Long 6° 34'

98. Wednesday 1st
First part light winds from the SE mid and latter part made saw a big saw a whale going quick to the SE down boat no catch them
Lat 32° 18' Long 6° 42'

99. Thursday 2nd
First part calm saw a whale bow and could not get fast one sail in sight mid and latter part moderate saw two whales chased them
Lat 32° 50' Long 7° 02'
