

Friday 8th November
Light winds from the NW and fine weather several ships in sight steering NW middle part and fresh water part thick and squally
Lat 34° 15' S Long 61° 33' E

Saturday 9th
Begins with light winds from the NW and thick heading saw fin and hump backs at night took in sail mid part moderate made sail latter part fresh winds and squally reefed the topsails Lat 35° 15' S Long 61° 33' E

Sunday 10th
Commences with strong winds from the NW at 5 PM tacked ship to the NW at 7 PM took in sail mid part more moderate made sail saw a fin back saw two ships steering NW latter part pleasant saw porpoise took out at 35° 44' S Long 61° 18' E

Monday 11th
Begins with light winds from the NW and fine weather at dark took in sail two ships in sight at 1 PM to the S latter part squally one ship in sight
Lat 34° 25' S Long 61° 18' E

Tuesday 12th
First part strong winds and squally one ship in sight ahead at 7 PM the sail heading NW wind NW middle part and made sail two sail in sight
Lat 34° 25' S Long 61° 18' E

Wednesday 13th
Begins with light winds from the NW at 1 PM saw a fin back middle and latter part light winds and pleasant saw hump backs at 11 AM and fresh
Lat 33° 28' S Long 61° 50' E

Thursday 14th November
Begins with fresh winds from the NW at 1 PM tacked to the NW saw hump back at 4 PM reefed the topsails at dark shortened sail steering NW middle part squally at 10 PM took in the fore topsail fished with heavy gales Lat 33° 40' S Long 60° 0' E

Friday 15th
First part strong gales from the S steering SE at 4 PM more moderate the topsails close reefed middle and latter part moderate weather a forehose Lat 33° 21' S Long 60° 0' E

Saturday 14th
Begins with gentle breezes from the S saw fin backs at dark tacked to the NW and shortened sail mid part and latter part calm Lat 33° 25' S Long 60° 0' E

Sunday 15th
Commences with light air and calms one ship off the lee tomorrow for a whale at dark came on board and took in sail mid and latter part light winds and fine weather saw several fin backs a ship ahead Lat 33° 39' S Long 60° 0' E

Monday 16th
Begins with light winds from the NW and fine weather course SE at dark took in sail at 7 PM made sail latter part strong breeze reefed the topsails spoke 3 PM London Packet, pennant 18 months out 1800 lbs Lat 34° 02' S Long 60° 58' E

Tuesday 17th
First part strong winds from the NW close reefed the topsails latter part moderate turned out reef saw two ships backs Lat 34° 30' S Long 60° 24' E

Wednesday 18th
Commences with light winds from the NW saw fin backs tonight a forehose at 7 PM took in sail mid part wind light made sail latter part calm ambient the fore topsail Lat 34° 58' S Long 60° 26' E
