

Thursday 19th

Commences with light winds from the NE and fulcrum at dark took in sail heaving to the westward made fast calm latter part light winds from the NW saw a whale chased him until noon, saw humpbacks

Lat 35° 12' Long 144° E

Friday 20th

First part light winds from the NW saw humpbacks at dark took in sail middle and latter part light winds and fine weather saw humpbacks

Lat 36° 11' Long 00 54 E

Saturday 21st

Begins with fresh winds from the NW saw humpbacks saw a sail starting SE and latter part mod and thick humpbacks in sight

Lat 38° 28' Long 0 45 East

Sunday 22nd

First part light winds from NW and fog tacked to the NE took in sail middle and latter part no alteration

Lat 37° 16' Long 1° 30'

Monday 23rd

Begins with fresh winds from the NW and fulcrum at dark took in sail for the night middle part mod latter part strong winds and thick fog

Tuesday 24th

Strong winds from the NW and foggy the breeze mod let out reef one sail in sight steering S at dark took in sail heading N latter part strong winds and squally ship under double reefed topsails saw humpbacks

Lat 34° 32' Long 2° 11'

Wednesday 25th

Begins with strong winds from NW and rough tacked ship took saw a whale towards could not get fast took in sail at 10 left off E saw humpbacks

Lat 34° 44' Long 3° 08'

Thursday 26th November

Commences with fresh winds from the NW and fulcrum at sun set saw a whale towards the boat could not get up with light took in sail and hove to heading SE middle part squally furled the foresail at 10 made sail saw whales struck one and drew caught a porpoise

Lat 34° 53' Long 4° 15' W

Friday 27th

Begins with light winds from the NW and fine weather at dark took in sail heading SE middle part calm latter part light winds and fulcrum course SE saw fin backs

Lat 34° 53' Long 4° 41'

Saturday 28th

First part light winds from the NW and fine weather saw fin backs middle and latter part wind and weather about the same two ships in sight saw two whales chased them No 28

Sunday 29th

Begins with light winds and fulcrum saw a whale chased him until sun set came on board took in sail mid part mod made sail saw fin backs saw two ships steering Westward

Lat 35° 16' Long 6° 55'

Monday 30th

Commences with light winds two sail in sight at sun set saw a whale down board and gave chase came on board close reefed the topsails mid part mod made sail at 10 saw a whale darted but did not fasten

Lat 33° 19' Long 5° 33'

Tuesday 1st December

Gentle winds from the NW saw a whale darted he being under water did not fasten came on board took in sail heading SE at 10 made sail three ships in sight sending to the Westward

Lat 34° 55' Long 6° 38'
