- 137 First, fair, strong winds from S.W. and rough at dusk took in sail middle part moderate made sail recked to the W. latter part fine weather all sail set at 3⁰⁰ Lat 35° 02' Long 51° 02' E

Monday 14th

- 138 Begins with mod winds from the W. and pleasant weather one ship in sight, caught a porpoise at 10 took in sail at 11 made sail and chased whales Lat 35° 15' Long 49° 32' E

Tuesday 15th

- 139 Light winds and fine weather saw whales down boat took one to the ship at 10 finished cutting took in sail and commenced hauling latter part chased whales could not get past Lat 34° 59' Long 51° 02' E

Wednesday 16th

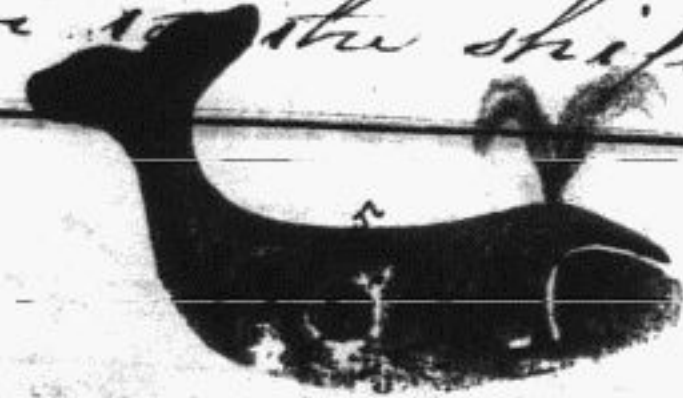
- 140 Commences with light winds from S.W. and fine weather saw whales lowered ^{spiked} ~~stowed~~ ^{down} ~~away~~ and last the line struck another and took him to the ship and commenced cutting Lat 4° 05'

Thursday 17th

- 141 First, fair, light winds from N.W. and pleasant, saw whales going quick at 10 saw a sail stirring J.E. at dusk took in sail mid and latter part moderate employed in stowing down Lat 34° 43' Long 49° 52'

Friday 18th

- 142 Commences with light winds from the N.W. P.M. saw a whale down boat and gave chase at dusk close reefed the topsails A.M. saw whales struck one and lost a line struck another and took her to the ship Lat 4° 35'



Saturday 19th December

- 143 Begins with light winds from the N.W. a plenty of whales in sight killed one at 10 P.M. got him along side and took in sail latter part employed in stowing down Lat 35° 02' Long 51° 02' E

Sunday 20th

- 144 Commences with light winds from S.W. and pleasant, commenced cutting finished cutting began to boil mid part more mod at 11 made sail saw a whale latter part fresh wind from the N.W. took in sail Lat 34° 59' Long 51° 02' E

Monday 21st

- 145 First, strong winds from North ship under shaly sail heading to saw a whale mid part moderate commenced stowing oil saw whales struck and cut boat filled latter part strong winds took in sail Lat 35° 20' Long 51° 02' E

Tuesday 22nd

- 146 Commences with strong winds from S.W. and rugged middle part about the same latter part light and pleasant saw whales Lat 34° 59' Long 49° 39' E

Wednesday 23rd

- 147 Begins with light winds from S.W. plenty of whales in sight took one to the ship took in sail and lay by the whale A.M. cut the whale in mid with strong winds Lat 35° 00' Long 49° 52' E

Thursday 24th

- 148 Strong winds from N.W. and rough employed in stowing down middle part squally latter part thick and rainy with strong gales furlled the fore sail
