 163 Commences with light winds from

 latter part light air varnished the
 masts Lat 36° 08' Long 4° 52' E

Saturday 9th
 164 First part, mod mild N unben
 the main topsail mended it sent up
 saw a brig steering SE middle and latter
 part wind and weather about the
 same saw a barge steering SE

Sunday 10th
 165 Commences with light winds from the
 N at dark reefed the topsails mid part
 thick and rainy at 10 made sail saw
 fin backs ends with thick weather
 No 06s

Monday 11th
 166 Begins with fresh winds from the N
 and thick took in sail and hove to
 middle and latter part about the same

Tuesday 12th
 167 Begins with moderate winds and rain
 weather at 2 P.M. luffed to heading with
 mod mid and latter part no
 attraction Lat 37° 00' Long 5° 00'

Wednesday 13th
 168 light winds from the north made
 sail at 7 took in sail and hove to head
 ing SW mid part mod made sail
 latter part pleasant, all sail set
 Lat 41° 40' Long 6° 27' E

Thursday 14th January
 169 Commences with fresh winds from
 N W and pleasant, luffed to the NE
 at dark reefed the topsails heading
 NE at 12 passed a ship steering SW
 latter part thick and rainy with
 light winds Lat 40° 06'

Friday 15th
 170 Begins with light air and calm and
 thick weather at night shortened sail
 mid part mod latter part saw
 a whale chased him darted
 Lat 39° 59' Long 7° 13' E

Saturday 16th
 171 light winds from the SE saw a
 whale lowered but did not strike
 at dark took in sail heading SW
 latter part light winds and
 pleasant, saw a whale lowered
 struck and took him to the ship
 Lat 40° 06'

Sunday 17th
 172 Commences with light winds
 from the NE and pleasant, at 2 P.M.
 luffed to the SE at dark took
 in sail heading SW mid
 part mod latter part thick
 fog saw a whale Lat

Monday 18th
 173 Commences with light winds from
 the N and thick mid and latter
 part light winds and pleasant
 commenced boiling saw whale
 chased them could not catch him
 Lat 40° 04' Long 6° 29'

Tuesday 19th
 174 Begins with light winds from the
 SE and pleasant, chased whale
 finished boiling took in sail
 latter part thick fog saw
 a whale and caught a five piece
 up in clear Lat 40° 06' Long 6° 30'
