

Wednesday 20th January
 115 Commences with light winds from NW and pleasant at dark took in sail heading to the W & W wind shifts to the S. Chased whales spoke ship Bengal of Salem Coasts Lat 40° 10' N Long 5° 30' E

Thursday 21st
 116 Begins with strong winds from S at 2 PM took to the S & S the mizen topsail at dark took in sail middle and latter part strong gales Lat 40° 09' N Long 6° 45' E

Friday 22nd
 117 Commences with heavy gales from NW middle part inclined to moderate at 4 AM wind S & latter part heavy gales and thick weather No 115

Saturday 23rd
 118 Begins with heavy gales from NW ship heading NW mid part squally latter part strong gales and clear Lat 39° 04' N Long 7° 44' E

Sunday 24th
 119 First part heavy gales from the NW and rough saw a sail middle part squally latter part more moderate took the fore and mizen topsails took to the S a heavy swell Lat 38° 36' N Long 7° 47' E

Monday 25th
 120 Begins with fresh winds from the NW course S by W under double reefed topsails at dark close reefed the topsails mid and latter part more mod let out reefs mid and thick weather Lat 39° 59' N Long 8° 25' E

Tuesday 26th
 121 Begins with mod winds from the NW and thick at 4 AM fresh reefed the topsails mid part strong gales furled the fore sail at 5 inclined to moderate set the topsails double reefed at 9 fresh gales took in sail Lat 40° 45' N Long 8° 37' E

Wednesday 27th
 122 Commences with strong winds from NW and rough NW by S the topsails double reefed at dark took in sail have too heading NW middle part light winds at 4 made sail latter part calm Lat 40° 23' N Long 7° 21' E

Thursday 28th
 123 Begins with light winds from NW and pleasant at 6 PM saw a whale to windward took in sail at 8 made sail I then saw a school of blackfish took one to the ship latter part fresh winds reefed the topsails Lat 40° 03' N

Friday 29th
 124 Begins with strong winds from the NW thick and raining took in sail more to the NW mid part mod made sail latter part strong winds reefed the topsails Lat 40° 09' N Long 6° 30' E

Saturday 30th
 125 Fresh winds from the NW and a large sea chased whales at dark took in sail heading N mid part squally more ship made sail took to the S saw a fin back Lat 40° 00' N Long 5° 51' E

Sunday 31st
 126 Commences with light winds from NW and pleasant saw a fin back at dark reefed the topsails course NW mid and latter part moderate with fog Lat 40° 20' N Long 5° 42' E

Monday 1st February
 127 Moderate winds from the NW and thick weather at 8 close reefed the topsails mid and latter part strong winds and rough Lat 40° 45' N Long 5° 37' E
