

Remarks onboard ship Edward Quinn
June the 15th 1825

born with moderate gales and thick fog from
E & N E and steering by the wind N by W under
all sail at 4 P M the fog cleared up & saw
long Island & saw five Island light bearing
W by N dist about 7 leagues off track of shore Middle
part ditto at 4 P M tracked in shore under Jucker
Reefed topsails at 8 M saw three lands tracked off
the 20 and heavy & foggy

Sat by 40-25 D R 40 30 S by 42-54

Sunday the 16th

born with fog and Nam wind at E under Jucker
Reefed topsails W Middle part light wind latter part
ditto calm brought 8 or 10 fathoms in 90 fathoms
Water with white sand & black specks &c
20 ends as per to day Sat by D R 40-25

Monday the 17th

born with light winds from S E & thick fog
steering N E by E under easy sail middle part
latter ditto ditto rain with very much
to day Sat by D R 40-31

Tuesday the 18th

born with light winds from W & steering N E
under easy sail at 2 P M the fog cleared up
and saw the number of 10 schooners &c at 4 P M saw
Montez Point bearing N E dist 7 leagues off Middle
by a bark headed off shore at daylight saw a
Pilot Boat and took a Pilot & steered for New
Port 20 ends as per Sat 41-18

Wednesday the 19th

born with light winds from W & steering
N E by N for New Port harbour at 4 P M came
to an anchor in New Port in 5 fathom water with
the starboard anchor the port bearing S W by
dist inside off Middle part fine weather latter
part ditto employed in various jobs
20 ends in New Port

Lying in New Port June the
Saturday the 11 1825

born with fine weather employed in
various jobs Middle Part fine latter Part
thick fog employed in fitting the Rigging
20 ends 10 men short

Sunday the 12th

born with thick fog light winds from S E
Middle Part ditto latter Part fine weather
5 men come onboard from the shore
to go to sea & discharged 3 sick ones sent

Monday the 13th

born with fine weather Middle Part ditto
latter part the same employed in
setting up the rigging &c 20 ends

Tuesday the 14th

born with fine weather employed in setting
up the rigging &c Middle Part fine & men
run & way had back and West & down
latter Part ditto 20 ends

Wednesday the 15th

born with light winds & Middle part
ditto latter Part wind from S W
20 ends lying at New Port

Thursday the 16th

born with fine weather wind at S Middle
Part wind at S E latter Part 20 ends
all hands onboard

Friday the 17th

born with light winds from S Middle
Part ditto latter part much the same
20 ends all onboard
