

Ship Edward Inesnet Full on
June the 18th

born with squally weather & changeable wind
Middle part squally at daylight have shoot
& got underway & the ship paid off & got ashore
on the flat so end laid on shore

Sunday the 19th

born with light wind from S lying a shore
Part employed in getting the ship off got her off
at 8 AM have shoot and got under way & made all
sail and got down under loudcut Island the wind us
We anchored so ends lying at anchor

Monday the 20th

born with fine weather Wind at SW got underway &
Made all sail beating out the River at 2 PM discharge
The pilot & at 7 PM made St. Marks land bore ESE
Distance 7 leagues & from S take my departure steering
SE by E Middle part squally latter part ditto saw
nothing thick fog No Obs to day Lat DR 39^o
Lgd 62-55 W

Tuesday the 21st

born with Moderate gales from ESE and steering
by the wind SE at 6 PM there ships to SE under
all sail Middle part wind at 24 & heading E
latter part heading E by S saw blackfille lowered
But all in vain so end in the Lat Obs 39-38 W
DR 39-38 Lgd 58-20 W

Wednesday the 22nd

born with fine weather Wind at S by W steering
E by S under all sail Middle part double Reefed tops
squally latter part ditto saw nothing No Obs Lat
by DR 39-34 N Lgd 64-51 W

Ship Edward Inesnet 3 day out
June the 20th 1830

born with squally weather Wind at from W & W
& steering E by S set the Main top & sails & Middle
Part fine weather latter part ditto under all sail
Saw 4 ships standing ESE under all sail at 4 PM
steered ESE so ends Lat Obs 39-50 Lgd 64-5
Thursday the 24th

born with Moderate gales from W & fine weather
under drawing sail steering E by S at 4 PM steered
ESE Middle Part wind from W latter part off all
& heading by the wind ESE saw two ships so ends
employed in ships ditto No Obs to day S by SE
Saturday the 25th 39-25 N Lgd 67-55 W

born with strong gales from ESE at 4 PM took in
Main top & sail & at 6 PM double Reefed the
Luffsails and took in the jib & Middle Part double Reefed
the fore and main top-sails and took in the main
top-sail & at 8 PM took in the fore top-sail
have too heading SE saw nothing No Obs
Lat by DR 40-39 Lgd ditto 59-49 W

Sunday the 26th

born with strong gales from ESE heading
to SE took in the fore sail blowing heavy
& Raining Middle Part more moderate
set double Reef top-sails latter Part made all sail
steering ESE W at 8 PM saw nothing
so ends in Lat 39-34 DR 39-44 Lgd 55-35 W
