

Ship Edward Desrochers of Fall River

September the 14 1890

came with light winds from S S W steering by the wind at 4 P M strong gales from S E and steering off S W that kept the topsails & built the fore sail & S. Part more moderate latter Part ditto Made all sail and sailed to S S W heading W at meridian wind shifted to S W heading W S W under all sails so ends in the lat 57-29 Long 71-25 W

Thursday the 15

came with moderate gales from S W steering by the wind off S W under all sail at 6 P M. Wind shifted to W S W heading S W S. Part squally Wind at 11 P M headed S W better Part heading W S W Wind at 1 P M saw nothing so ends under double reefed topsails & S. Part No Obs to Day Lat by DR 56-59 Long 71-25 W

Friday the 16



came with strong gales from S W and steering by the wind under double reefed topsails & S. Part at 6 P M. More ships to south saw 4 ships standing to S W Part more ship to S at 7 P M own ship to W wind at 1 P M saw one Island of ice so ends under double reefed topsails in the lat 57-20 Long 72-20 W

Saturday the 17

came with strong gales from S S W steering by the wind off S W under double reefed topsails & S. Part ditto ditto at 4 P M saw one Island of ice so ends No Obs to Day Lat by DR 55-42 Long 75-24 W

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15

September the 18 1890

came with strong gales from S S W steering by the wind off S W under double reefed topsails & S. Part ditto ditto at 4 P M saw one Island of ice so ends No Obs to Day Lat by DR 54-20 Long 75-24 W

Monday the 19

came with moderate gales from S S W steering by the wind at meridian wore ship to S under all sail Middle Part Doubled Reefed topsails latter Part saw nothing No Obs to Day Lat by DR 54-20 Long 75-24 W

Tuesday the 20

came with strong gales from S S W steering by the wind S W under double reefed topsails at 2 P M took into jib & main sail & last built the fore & main topsails & at 4 P M saw one Church ship valiant A whale ship bound to the coast of Chile after night whale Middle Part squally latter Part ditto saw nothing so ends in the lat 56-05 Long 80-20 W

Wednesday the 21

came with strong gales from S S W steering by the wind at meridian wore ship to S S W under reefed topsails jib and main sail Middle Part more moderate made all sail latter Part ditto saw nothing so ends No Obs to Day Lat by DR 54-49 Long 80-20 W

Thursday the 22

came with light winds & foggy from S steering by the wind under all sail Middle Part ditto latter Part fine weather saw nothing so ends in the lat 52-24 Long 79-20 W
