

Ship Edward Quernel on Chile

November the 10th 1836
 Low with strong gales from N.W. employed
 in chasing Whales the Waist Boat struck &
 had to cut at dark stored by the wind N.W.
 Boiling Middle and latter Part ditto foggy saw
 Whales lowered and chased but all in vain
 so ends in the Late 43-50 Lgd 70

Friday the 11th
 Low with light winds and foggy from S.E.
 storing by the wind S.W. under short sail at 9
 finished cutting Middle and latter Part foggy
 employed in storing down oil in the main
 but heavy so ends in the Late 47-40 Lgd 70-50

Saturday the 12th
 Low with light winds and foggy from S.W. and
 storing down oil at 8 A.M. the ship to S.W. under
 short sail Middle Part and latter ditto saw whales
 employed in storing down in the Late 44-06 Lgd 70-50

Sunday the 13th
 Low with light winds from S.W. storing by
 the wind S.E. under short sail saw whales employed
 in storing down at 8 A.M. finished Middle Part
 ditto latter Part fine spoke the House off barrow
 saw whales so ends in the Late 44-00 L

Monday the 14th
 Low with light winds from S employed in chasing
 whales the waist Boat struck and got the whale took
 him to the ship & cabled him Middle Part ditto
 at daylight commenced cutting and at meridian
 finished 8 ships in sight some boiling & some cutting
 so ends in the Late 47-40 Lgd 70-20



Whaling Yet

November the 15th 1836
 Low with fine weather employed in chasing
 Whales the Waist Boat struck and got the whale
 took him to the ship and cabled him and at 10 P.M.
 commenced boiling Middle and latter Part ditto at 8
 A.M. saw cutting at meridian finished so ends
 in the Late 43-50 Lgd 70 W.

Wednesday the 16th
 Low with strong gales from S. storing
 by the wind E.S.E. at 2 P.M. spoke the Lardened
 of barrow and 4 P.M. took in fore and mizen
 to reach saw whales still boiling Middle Part
 ditto at 8 A.M. saw whales the Lardened
 Boat struck and caught him took him to the
 ship at 8 A.M. still a boiling saw in the
 Late 45-5-8

Thursday the 17th
 Low with fine weather wind at S.S.E. at 2 P.M.
 commenced cutting and at 9 P.M. finished Middle
 Part boiling and storing by the wind S.E.
 under short sail latter Part Boiling saw
 whales so ends in the Late 43-50 Lgd 75-50

Friday the 18th
 Low with strong gales from S.E. storing by the
 wind under short sail Boiling & boiling Middle
 Part Boiling could not boil latter Part more
 moderate commenced boiling saw nothing
 so ends in the Late 44-40 Lgd 77
