 have all sail stored. No by N saw nothing
 sounds in the Leds 45-52 - 53-54-55

Saturday the 31

Down with fine clear weather wind
 at 5 P.M. steering N.E. under all sail at 6
 P.M. took in the fore and main topmasts
 and double reef to the main Middle part
 hauled to the wind to 4 P.M. the latter part
 made all sail and stored in the cargo saw one ship

saw in the Leds 49-54

January the 1 1837

Down with fine weather wind at 5 P.M.
 meridian went in with a boat after wood and
 fish could not get any fish but some wood
 and shot some small game on board at 7 P.M.
 Double reef to the main topmast heading off shore
 at 8 P.M. Middle and latter part set the main
 topmast hauled but all in main sounds

in the Leds 44-55 56-57

Munday the 2

Down with strong gale from S.W. saw no
 game on board could not catch. Then to rugged
 at 6 P.M. took in fore and main topmasts and
 double reef to the main heading off shore. The
 latter part set the fore ship to N.E. latter part set
 sounds in the Leds 45-46-47-48

Tuesday the 3

Down with strong gale from S.W. and
 at 8 P.M. under double reef topmast and set
 at 6 P.M. took in fore and main topmasts Middle
 part Braine latter part set to N.E. fine
 weather wind at 11 P.M. stored S.W. set double
 reef towards sounds in the Leds 42-50 51-52

Wednesday the 4

Down with moderate gale from S.W.
 and steered S.W. under double reef topmast
 and at 6 P.M. were ship took in fore and
 main topmasts Middle part set the latter
 part set fore and main topmast and stored
 48
