

Ship Edward Duval

Thursday the 5-1837

bon. with moderate gales and equally strong
in for port of St. Barles at 4 P.M. hauled
to the wind to St. Middle Port tacked and half
tacked at 6 AM made all sail and steered in for
the harbour and at 8 AM came to anchor in
6 fathoms water, half a mile from the shore
so ends first day in port

Friday the 6

bon. with Boring weather wind at S.W. off
middle Port Boring latter ditto got of one raft
of water and all hands employed
and so ends in port

Saturday the 7

bon. with moderate gales and rather Wind N.W.
sent in a raft for water Middle Port Boring
latter Port more fine got of the raft of water
all hands employed in cleaning ship
so ends in port

Sunday the 8

bon. with light winds from N.W. and fine weather
Middle and latter Port fine one watch on shore
on liberty so ends day in Port yet

Monday the 9

fine weather wind at S Middle Port ditto
latter Port Boring one watch on shore
and so ends

On Chalk yet
In Port yet

January the 10 1837

Boring weather Wind at N Middle Port fine latter
ditto employed in scraping the coast
and all hands employed so ends this days work

Wednesday the 11

bon. with fine weather employed in cleaning ship
Middle Port fine latter Port Boring so ends in Port yet

Thursday the 12

bon. with strong gale from N.W. Boring at 6 AM
let go the starboard anchor under foot Middle Port ditto
latter Port took him up employed in painting one watch
on shore so ends

Friday the 13

bon. with fine weather employed in painting
on watch on shore Middle Port ditto latter Port Boring
so ends in Port

Saturday the 14

bon. with Boring weather wind at N.W. Middle
Port ditto latter Port fine employed in painting
ship and stowing down water between decks so ends

Sunday the 15

bon. with fine weather wind at N.W. employed
in painting Middle Port ditto latter Port the same
went up the fore top & mast and flying jib
so ends in port yet
