January the 11 1837
 born with strong wind from S.E. steering W.S.W.
 at 4 P.M. sent in the boat and at 1 P.M.
 came off with 4 few fish brace up and
 cleared off by 4 Middle Part steered W.S.W.
 latter Part ditto employed in repairing old
 sails and saw masts and so ends in the
 Late 33-40 S Lgd 77

Saturday the 11
 born with light Winds from S steering W.S.W.
 under Easy sail at 2 P.M. shifted the foretop
 sent the old one one sent the mizen top sail
 middle Part color latter Part ditto same sail
 sent the fore and mizen top sails flying put
 mizen top sails and so ends in the Late 33-40 S
 Lgd 78-90

Sunday the 5
 born with calm middle Part ditto latter Part
 light Winds from S and steering W.S.W. under
 all sail so ends in the Late 33-40 S

Monday the 6
 born with light winds from S and steering W.S.W.
 under all sail at 4 P.M. spoke the barken of
 New Bedford 15 months out 1500 Middle Part
 headed off latter Part color saw nothing employed
 in repairing old sails and so ends in the Late
 33-44 Lgd 80-94

Tuesday the 7
 born with light winds from S.W. steering by
 the wind off S.W. under all sail middle Part ditto
 latter Part the same saw nothing took in the
 starboard boat and put out another one employed
 in repairing boats so ends in the Late 33-40
 Lgd 89-90 W

Ship Edward Quenel

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February the 8 1837
 born with light winds from S.W. and steering
 by the wind off at 4 P.M. wore ship to S.E.
 saw a sail and saw Blue fish hurried around
 and could not catch them Middle Part heading
 S.W. latter Part ditto under the fore sail
 employed in repairing it put out the bow
 boat saw a ships smoke in the Late 33-40
 Lgd 79-85

Thursday the 9
 born with strong gales from S.E. steering by
 the wind under double Reef top sails and Middle
 Part strong gales latter Part made all sail
 saw a sail employed in repairing the fore
 sail and so ends in the Late 32-50 Lgd 81-92

Friday the 10
 born with moderate gales from S.E. steering
 by the wind S.W. under all sail and at 2 P.M.
 sent the fore sail and at 4 P.M. shortened and
 middle Part ditto latter Part made all sail started
 off S.W. saw nothing so ends in the Late 33-44 S

Saturday the 11
 born with light from E.W. at 2 P.M. wore
 ship to S.W. under all sail Middle Part ditto
 latter Part the same saw nothing employed
 in repairing old sails so ends in the Late 32-44
 Lgd 85-97
