March the 1st 1837

born with calm breeze & W under all sail Middle Part & latter Part ditto saw nothing - records in the late 15-30

Thursday the 2^d

born with light wind calm & W and steering off 1/2 W under all sail Middle and latter Part ditto employed in stowing down oil in the after hold records in the late 14-55

Friday the 3^d

born with light wind from SE and steering off 1/2 W under all sail stowing down oil yet Middle Part calm latter Part ditto finished boiling the whale and stowing down the oil records in the late 16-55

Saturday the 4th

born with light wind from SE and steering off 1/2 W under all sail Middle Part ditto saw nothing employed in various jobs records in the late 16-55

Sunday the 5th

born with light wind from different points of the compass steering off 1/2 W under all sail Middle Part ditto latter Part saw plenty off drift wood records in the late 16-55

Bound the coast

March the 6th 1837

born with light wind from NW 1/2 W at 10 P M saw a hump-backed porpoise & a shark but all in vain Middle Part fine latter Part ditto employed in stowing down the rigging fore & aft late 15-40

Tuesday the 7th

born with fine weather employed in rattling down rigging at 1 P M lowered after bump backs & the starboard shrouds one and killed him & he sank Middle Part fine latter Part ditto stowed W by 1/2 W records late 15-30

Wednesday the 8th

born with fine weather steering off 1/2 W under all sail employed in rattling down and at 10 P M finish Middle Part fine latter Part ditto shifted the fore tops employed remaining in tarring down rigging records in the late 14-50

Thursday the 9th

born with light wind from SE and steering off 1/2 W under all sail at 4 P M shifted the main topmast middle Part fine latter Part ditto employed in tarring down records in the late 14-55
