

Remarks On Board

April the 6 1837

born with light wind & steering by the
wind ESE under all sail Middle Part &
latter the same course in the lat 4-12
Lgt 83-50

Friday the 7th

born with fine weather wind at SE steering
by the wind ESE under all sail employed
in breaking out the after hold to stow
down in all Middle Part & latter much
the same employed in stowing down
all and so ends in the lat 3-17 Lgt 83

Saturday the 8th

born with pleasant weather wind at
SE steering by ESE under all sail at 8 AM
steered W Middle and latter Part ditto
steered N by E employed in stowing down
the oil lat 1-52 Lgt 82-28

Sunday the 9th

born with fine weather wind at SE steering
by the wind ESE under all sail stowed
down Middle fine latter Part ditto finished
stowing down in the lat 2-8
saw 1 ship

Monday the 10th

born with fine weather steering by
the wind ESE under all sail at
2 PM spoke the ships Conway and
Charles of London Middle Part
by aback & at 2 PM braces forward
to ESE latter Part ditto saw nothing
so ends in the lat 1-57 Lgt 81-10

Ship Edward Quersnel

April the 11 1837

born with moderate gales from SE
steering ESE under all sail at 2 PM
saw the main land and at 6 AM ship
to NW under all sail Middle Part light
winds latter Part calm ends in the
lat 1-44

Tuesday the 12th

born with light winds from NW
and steering ESE under all sail Middle
Part latter Part wind at S
& steered NW & W saw nothing so ends
in the lat 1-31 Lgt 82-18

Wednesday the 13th

born with moderate trades and steering
by the wind under all sail W & W at
4 PM steered E & Wore ship to ESE
Middle Part ditto latter Part heading
S & by E saw the main roads in the
lat 1-55 Lgt 82 W

Thursday the 14th

born with moderate trades SE steering
by the wind under all sail at 2
PM wore ship to SE by S at 6
PM wore ship ESE saw a sail &
the land roads in the lat of 1-15
Lgt 81

Friday the 15th

born with light winds and calm
saw blackfish lowered and the
Waist boat got one took him to
the ship at 6 PM wore ship to SE
under all sail saw the line caught
a saw fish so ends in the lat
2-22 S
