Monday the 16 1839
 born with fine weather wind at
 sea steering off by the wind
 sail. Middle Part fine latter saw
 nothing. wind to ESE & saw
 nothing. employed in setting
 up. Shocks in sea 4.

Tuesday the 17
 born with fine weather wind at
 sea steering by the wind ESE & under
 all sail middle Part fine latter
 Part latter saw nothing. rocks in
 the sea 8-19 8

Wednesday the 18
 born with fine weather wind at SE
 steering by the wind ESE & under
 all sail. Middle Part fine latter saw
 nothing. employed in
 setting up. Shocks rocks in the
 sea 3-10 5-10 5-10 4

Thursday the 19
 born with fine weather wind at SE
 steering by the wind ESE & under all sail
 middle Part & latter the same steering in
 for timber. rocks in the sea 3-10

Friday the 20
 born with fine weather steering in for
 timber. at 6 PM came to anchor in
 10 fathoms water with 8 fathoms
 of chain middle Part fine latter got off 100
 lbs of water & stowed it down
 and is now in port. Sea 3-21 5

In Port Again

May the 21st
 born with fine weather employed in
 stowing down water middle Part
 fine latter latter employed in getting
 of water 500 lbs 10 and 10 all well

Monday the 22nd
 born with fine weather employed in
 stowing down water middle & latter
 Part fine and sound

Tuesday the 23rd
 born with fine weather employed in
 stowing away water middle Part fine
 latter Part fine got off 10 Raft

Wednesday the 24th
 born with fine weather employed in stowing
 away water got off one raft middle
 & latter Part latter rocks in port 4

Thursday the 25th
 born with fine weather employed in
 stowing away water got off one raft
 middle & latter latter rocks in port

Friday the 26th
 born with fine weather employed in
 wooding middle Part fine latter Part
 latter rocks
