May the 27 1837
Ave with fine weather & employed
in working Middle last fine latter
all part of the land of ground
scow in port part.

Sunday the 28
Ave with fine weather employed
in working middle last fine latter
last part of the day.

Monday the 29
Ave with fine weather middle
last fine latter last little scow

Tuesday the 30
Ave with fine weather at 4 PM got
under way and made all sail stores
by the wind & West of Port the Island is
near here while distance a boat of lumber
off here thence I take my departure
leaving the wind S by middle last fine
latter part of the day scow
in the late 2-27 1837

Wednesday the 31
Ave with strong gales from S by S. leaving
West town top of sails & Middle last
fine latter last little at 10 PM scow
of scow anchors & lowered 4 boats the
harbour boat struck one and got
got him in line to the ship &
sailed him so ends in the late
1837 1837-18

the Ship

June the 1st 1837
Ave with fine weather employed
cutting at 3 PM finish cutting
board forward of the main & S by
wind short sail Middle last fine scow
with boating & stores & scow
in the late 2-27 1837

Friday the 2nd
Ave with fine weather weather
wind at south and stores & under
all sail employed in boating
middle last fine latter last little
finished boating & scow in the late
1837 1837

Saturday the 3rd
Ave with fine weather wind at S
leaving S by S under all sail
middle last fine latter last little scow
Chatham Island & Woods Island scow
in the late 1-21

Sunday the 4th
Ave with fine weather & leaving in
for Woods Island at 4 PM came to
an anchor near 10 fathoms with
the harbour anchor & 60 fathoms of
Chain Middle & latter part fine scow

Monday the 5th
Ave with fine weather middle last
fine latter last employed in turpentine
so ends all work
