 Sun with fine weather steering by the
 wind at 2 PM spoke the Robert
 Edwards 21 months out 1800 lbs. took
 ship to 8 AM at 1 PM took to 8
 middle and latter part ditto so end
 in the late 1-19-83

Sunday the 13
 Sun with light winds from S & steering
 by the wind & under all sail middle
 & latter part ditto saw nothing
 employed Repairing a boat
 so end in the late 50 miles S

Monday the 14
 Sun with light winds from SE & steering
 by the wind ESE under all sail middle
 & latter part ditto saw nothing employed
 in Repairing a boat so end in the
 late 15 miles S 85-40

Tuesday the 15
 Sun with fine weather wind at 8 SE
 & steering by the wind under all sail
 middle & latter part ditto saw nothing
 Repairing a boat so end in the
 late 4 miles S 84-20

Wednesday the 16
 Sun with fine weather wind at 8 SE
 & steering by the wind under all sail
 middle & latter part ditto saw nothing
 in Repairing the old one so end
 late 2 47 S 84-07
