 all sail at 2 PM shifted the foretop
 sail & middle & latter part fine employed
 in repairing sails & so ends in the
 Lat 3-30 Lng 89-20

Sunday the 25th
 born with strong winds from S & steering
 off by S under all sail Middle &
 latter part fine employed in repairing
 sails saw finbacks sound in the
 Lat 3-45 Lng 92-34

Monday the 26th
 born with fine weather wind at S
 & steering W by S under all sail
 middle & latter the same saw finbacks
 employed in repairing sails so ends
 in the Lat 3-55 Lng 94-45-4

Tuesday the 27th
 born with strong trades from S & S &
 steering W by S under all sail middle
 & latter part fine saw nothing employed
 in repairing sails so ends in the Lat
 4-25 Lng 97-19

 born with strong trades from S & S &
 steering W by S under all sail on bent
 the mainsail & bent the new one at
 6 PM double reefed the topsails Middle
 part ditto latter part set the main
 top & sail employed in repairing with
 so ends in the Lat 4-20 Lng 101-30

Thursday the 29th
 strong gales from S & steering W by S
 under all sail at 6 PM shortened sail
 middle & latter part the same saw a sail
 sound in the Lat 5-29 Lng 103-0

Friday the 30th
 born with moderate gales at 2 PM
 spoke the Warlock of Salem the
 550 Bbl 10 month old & heard the
 wind S by W under double reefed topsails
 middle & latter ditto were ship to S & S
 saw a ship sound in the Lat
 5-45 Lng 105-22

Saturday the 31st
 born with moderate gales from S & S &
 steering by the wind S & under single reef
 topsails Middle part ditto latter part
 set the main top & sail sound in the
 Lat 6-17 Lng 108-50
