Sunday the 2 1834

Sea with moderate gales from ESE & steering by the wind under all sail middle part fine latter part made all sail sound in the

Ltd 4-00 Lgd 103-40

Monday the 3

Sea with fine weather at meridian stand 18° 44' by 44' under all sail Middle & latter part fine saw nothing sound in the Ltd 5-59 Lgd 104-04 34

Tuesday the 4

Sea with fine weather & steering 88° 24' under all sail at 4 PM stood Middle & latter part fine saw nothing sound in the Ltd 4-51 Lgd 105-32

Wednesday the 5

Sea with fine weather & steering 88° 24' under all sail Middle and latter part fine saw nothing sound in the Ltd 4-41 Lgd 107-32

Thursday the 6

Sea with moderate gales from SE & steering 88° 24' by 44' under all sail at 6 PM took in top & sail flying jib and main sail middle part ditto latter part saw a sperm whale lowered and the larboard boat struck one and got him took him to the ship & cabled him for cutting so ends in the Ltd 4-57 Lgd 108

Remarks Onboard

Sunday the 7 1834

Sea with fine weather commenced cutting the whale cut in the body & by the head all night at daylight commenced cutting the head at 7 AM finished & braced forward to S under double reefed topsails so ends to day in the Ltd 4-57 Lgd 108-21

Saturday the 8

Sea with fine weather steering by the wind S under double reefed topsails so ends at 4 PM wore ship to SE Middle & latter part ditto so ends in the Ltd 4-45 Lgd 109

Sunday the 9

Sea with strong trades from ESE & steering by the wind SE under double reefed topsails & boiling at 4 PM wore ship to S took in the jib & spanker middle part fine latter part finished boiling & set the jib & main sail saw nothing so ends in the Ltd 5-15 Lgd 109-21

Monday the 10

Sea with strong trades from ESE and steering by the wind S under double reefed topsails at 5 PM wore ship to SE Middle & latter part ditto latter part fine saw nothing so ends in the Ltd 5-33 Lgd 108-30
