Sunday the 11 1834

bon with strong gale from ESE steering
by the wind ESE under double reef
topails Middle & latter Part ditto
saw nothing except in the lat 4-11

Tuesday the 12

bon with strong gale from ESE steering
by the wind ESE under double reef top
ails took in the main sail Middle & latter
Part ditto saw black fish & blackfish
got one & so on in the lat 2-43 S

Lgd 106-45

Wednesday the 13

bon with moderate gale from ESE steering
by the wind ESE under double reef topails
set the main sail at 5 PM lowered after
black fish got near middle & latter Part
fine employed in stowing down oil in the
fore hold & so on in the lat 2-08 S

Thursday the 14

bon with moderate gale from ESE steering
by the wind under double reef topails
middle and latter Part saw black fish
swarmed after them & boats & caught 5 of
them took them to the ship finished stowing
down and so on in the lat 57 miles S Lgd 106-50

bon with moderate gale from ESE and
steering by the wind ESE under all sail
middle & latter Part ditto saw nothing
employed in putting black fish
so on in the lat 25 miles N by 108-05

Sunday the 16

commenced with fine weather wind at
ESE steering by the wind ESE under all
sail middle & latter Part the same
saw nothing so much this day in the

Monday the 17

bon with fine weather wind at ESE &
steering by the wind ESE under all sail
middle and latter Part ditto saw nothing
at 10 AM the beach rope of the fore
topail parted about him and beat a
mother one so much to day in the lat 2-03 S

Lgd 103-45 S

Tuesday the 18

commenced with strong SE trade steering
by the wind ESE under all sail Middle
Part fine latter much the same saw
at sail at noonian took ship to S H
so on this day in the lat 2-05 S Lgd 103-43
