Sunday the 19 1897
 born with moderate gales SE steering
 by the wind S off at 3 P.M. took ship
 to ENE and spoke the Robert Edwards
 of W. I. at 19 00 at 9 P.M. were ship
 to ENE middle and latter part little
 saw nothing so ends in the latd
 2-03 N Lgd 103-20

Thursday the 20
 born with moderate gales from SE and
 steering by the wind ENE under all sail
 middle and latter part saw a sail pass
 to leeward on the Starboard tack saw
 nothing more so ends in the latd 2-16 N
 Lgd 102-15

Friday the 21
 born with moderate gales from SE and
 steering by the wind under all sail
 middle part saw latter part the same
 saw nothing so ends in the latd 2-28 N
 Lgd 100-20

Saturday the 22
 born with fine weather wind at SE steering
 by the wind ENE under all sail middle
 and latter part much the same saw nothing
 so ends in the latd 2-02 N Lgd 98-35 W

Sunday the 23
 born with strong trades from SSE steering
 by the wind E under all sail Middle &
 latter part little saw nothing so ends
 in the latd 2-19 Lgd 96-30

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Sunday the 24 1897
 born with strong trades from SE &
 steering by the wind ENE under all
 sail Middle & latter part much the same
 made a small amount in the latd 2-18 N

Monday the 25
 born with moderate trades from SE &
 steering by the wind ENE under all sail
 Middle and latter part little saw nothing
 in ships duty & so ends in the latd
 2-22 Lgd 92-29

Tuesday the 26
 born with strong trades from SE steering
 by the wind under all sail Middle &
 latter part saw Sulphur & Wrenwren
 Islands and at 11 A.M. saw sperm whales
 so ends in the latd 1-55 N

Wednesday the 27
 born with fine weather at 1 P.M. moved
 after which all 4 boats the Starboard and
 how boats got one took them to the ship
 cabled them & by by them all night at
 daylight commenced cutting them out & were
 hoisted forward by the wind under all sail
 so ends to day in the latd 2-05 Lgd 91-50
