

Remarks Onboard

August the 5 1837
 down with moderate gales from SSE
 steering by the wind & under all sail
 Middle & latter parts saw nothing so ends
 in the latitude 15° 15' N Long 50° 45'

Sunday the 6
 down with moderate breeze from SE
 by the wind under all sail at 5 PM
 spoke the barinthian of New Bedford
 2000 lbs Middle back ship to SE
 & at 6 PM back ship to SE saw
 nothing so ends in the 11 miles SE
 Lat 50° 50' N

Monday the 7
 down with moderate breeze from SE
 steering by the wind under all sail at 4
 PM saw the anchor land Middle part
 fine at 5 PM saw ships to west at 4
 AM War ship to SE and at 10 AM
 sent in the to see about watering so ends
 Lat 29 miles S

Tuesday the 8
 down with moderate gales from SSE
 And sent the Sham and at 2 PM
 came to an anchor in 50 fathoms
 5 fathoms water with the larboard
 anchor and 60 fathoms of Sham Middle
 Part fine latter Part got off a raft of
 water the larboard boat struck a hump
 back & at meridian got him dead & began
 towing him to the ship so ends

Remarks Onboard

August the 9 1837
 fine weather employed in towing the i-hala
 towed until 4 PM & then anchored him
 same onboard hauled in the water & then
 commenced towing again and at 9 PM got him
 along side & cabled him Middle Part fine latter
 Part employed in working & blacking the
 back & so ends in port //

Wednesday the 10
 down with fine weather employed in working
 & blacking the back middle & latter Part
 latter at 9 AM commenced cutting & at
 meridian finished and so ends all well

Friday the 11
 down with moderate gales from SSE
 employed in stowing down water & at 4 PM
 have short made all sail got under way
 & stowed the anchors hauly the wind to W
 And at 8 PM commenced boiling middle &
 latter Part latter at meridian finished boiling
 saw nothing so ends Lat 16 miles S

Saturday the 12
 down with strong breeze steering by the
 wind W by S at 4 PM were ship to SE
 Middle Part fine latter Part saw the land
 hump back blackfish and a sail at 9 AM
 took ship of shore by the wind W so ends
 Lat 25 miles S
