September the 21 1849
 Down with moderate gales from S steering
 by the wind E N E under all sail repaired
 the fore-top sail and at 4 P M outbeat the
 one from the yard & bent the other one
 at 5 P M were ship in shore at 8 A M
 were ship of shore at 11 P M in shore and
 in harbor the harbor boat the after
 Port tops down so ends the Sails 4-39

Friday the 22^d

Down with light wind from S steering
 by the wind E S E under all sail at 6 P M
 took ship of shore at midnight took in
 shore latter Part ditto even Sails 4-58

Sunday the 23

Down with moderate gales from south &
 steering by the wind in shore and at 5 P M
 came to anchor in Bay to in 9 fathoms
 water with the harbor boat anchor down
 with 60 fathoms chain and the Washington
 of San Luchas 600 lbs Middle & latter
 Part fine so ends one watch on shore in Bay

September the 24 1849
 Down with moderate weather one watch
 on shore Middle & latter Part ditto even
 one man devoted to day

Monday the 25

fine weather strong wind employed in
 blacking the bunks and one watch on
 shore Middle & latter Part ditto even

Tuesday the 26

Down with fine weather employed in
 ships duty one watch on shore Middle
 & latter Part ditto in Bay

Wednesday the 27

fine weather with moderate gales
 employed in ships duty one watch on
 shore middle and latter Part ditto

Thursday the 28

fine weather employed in ships duty
 one watch on shore middle & latter
 Part ditto so ends in Bay

Friday the 29

Down with fine weather employed in
 ships duty one watch on shore so ends
