September the 20-1837

Down with fine weather employed in ships
duties middle part all hands on board
latter part ditto & ends 4 men short

October the 1-1837

Down with fine weather employed in ships
duties middle & latter part fine & ends all
well in fact especially the girls

Monday the 2^d

fine weather employed in ships duties
middle and latter part fine & ends
all well

Tuesday the 3^d

Down with strong gale from S.W. at
2 P.M. got under way & set 3 top sails &
steered by the wind W by S middle part

Wednesday the 4th

Down with strong gale from S.W. &
steering by the wind S.W. at 8 P.M. took
in the main sail middle & latter part ditto
under all sail saw nothing & ends in the
late 5-15 S

Ship Edward Quernick

October the 5 1837

Down with fine weather steering in for
Cape under all sail at 4 P.M. sent the
boat in after a man and at 5 P.M. came off
Without him hauld the wind W by S
Middle & latter part much the same at
10 P.M. tacked ship in shore heading S.W. &
under all sail employed in repairing a
boat & ends in late 5-19 S Log 83 W

Thursday the 6th

Down with moderate gale from S.W. steering
by the wind S.W. under all sail middle &
latter part ditto saw a ship pass to leeward
heading in shore employed in repairing a
boat & ends late 5-40 Log 83

Friday the 7th

Down with moderate gale from S.W. steering
by the wind S.W. under all sail middle &
latter part ditto saw finbacks & blackfish
& ends in late 6-49 Log 85-53

Sunday the 8th

Down with moderate gale from S.W. steering
by the wind S.W. under all sail Middle
& latter part ditto saw blackfish & ends
in the late 7-39 Log 84-50
