

Remarks Onboard

October the 18 - 1857

Left with moderate trades from S & steering by the wind & under all sail at 6 AM took in top of sails middle & latter part much the same saw nothing - ends in Sails 12-25 Sgd 87-47

Thursday the 19

Left with moderate gale from S & at meridian took ship in shore S & under all sail middle & latter part ditto saw nothing - ends in Sails 11-45 Sgd 86-40

Friday the 20

Left with strong gale from S & steering by the wind S & under all sail at 4 PM saw it ahead & at 5 PM saw a large Whaler headed to windward lowered 2 boats & chased but all in vain at 6 PM took in the main top of sail Middle part fine backed latter part ditto for ends in Sails 11-44 S

Saturday the 21

Left with strong gale S & S & at meridian steered S & W until 4 PM and hauled the wind S & S & Middle & latter part ditto saw nothing - ends in Sails 11-40 Sgd 87 3/4

On Perimeter

October the 22 - 1857

Left with moderate gale from S & S & steering by the wind S & S & under all sail at 6 PM were ship to S & S & Middle & latter part ditto saw - blackfish tails 11-19 S

Sunday the 23

Left with strong trade & squally from S & steering by the wind S & S & under all sail at 4 PM took in the main top of sail Middle part strong gale doubled Rapt the top sails latter part ditto saw 2 or 3 whales & lowered and no ends chasing

Tuesday the 24

Left with strong gale employed in chasing whales & at 4 PM the bow boat struck one at 8 PM took him to the ship and calked him and by 10 PM all mended and at daylight commenced sailing and at 10 PM finished & braced forward by the wind S & S & ends in Sails 11-30 Sgd 87

Wednesday the 25

Left with strong trades from S & steering by the wind S & S & under all sail at 2 PM were ship to S & S & Middle & latter part ditto made sail and in sailing in the Sails 12-27 Sgd 87-30 S
