

Remarks Onboard

November the 14 1837
 born with moderate gale from S.W. &
 steering by the wind S.W. under all sail
 on board the flying jib & with it the
 fore & middle & latter part fine under
 the main sail & repaired & sent it again
 so and in the lat 8-20 long 83-30

Wednesday the 15
 born with fine weather. lowered after black
 fish & caught 4 took them to the ship
 & stored by the wind S.W. under all sail
 Middle & latter part ditto saw a schooner
 & finished the main sail & sent it
 so and in the lat 7-45 long 81-20

Thursday the 16
 born with fine weather steering by the wind
 S.W. under all sail. sent the flying jib
 Middle & latter part took ship in shore & at 8
 A.M. took ship off shore so and in the
 lat 7-38 long 81-30

Friday the 17
 born with fine weather wind at S.W. & steams
 by the wind S.W. under all sail Middle
 & latter part ditto employed in boiling
 the black fish and at meridian finished
 saw sperm whales so and in the lat 8-28
 long 83

Remarks Onboard

November the 18 1837
 born with fine pleasant weather at 1 P.M.
 lowered 3 boats the larboard & Whist
 boats stuck & caught 2 Whales 4 P.M.
 took them to the ship & cabled them
 by them all night at day light
 commenced cutting latter part ditto so and
 in the lat 8-24 long 82-50

Sunday the 19
 born with strong trade employed in
 cutting & cut in all except the cases
 & by them all night & at day light
 cut in one case & sent the other employed
 in boiling so and in the lat 8-23 long 83-30

Monday the 20
 born with moderate gale from S.W. &
 steering by the wind at 2 P.M. was when
 employed in boiling Middle & latter part
 ditto saw black fish so and in the lat
 8-02 long 82-50

Tuesday the 21
 born with moderate gale from S.W. &
 steering by the wind S.W. under all sail
 & boiling Middle & latter part ditto saw
 nothing so and in the lat 7-30 long 81-30
