November the 22-1857

born with fine weather wind at 3 P.M. & steering by the wind S 50 E under all sail & looking Middle & latter part of the saw blackfish were ship at 7 A.M. finished looking so end in the late 7-30 Log 82-37

Thursday the 23

born with moderate gale from SE & steering by the wind S 40 E under all sail at 4 P.M. top in the top & sails Middle Part fore latter Part mid - all sails saw blackfish lowered and caught 5 in. end in the late 7-45 Log 85-24

Friday the 24

born with moderate gale from S 50 E steering by the wind S 50 E under all sail at 4 P.M. backed ship to 8 Middle Part backed to 8 latter Part ditto saw nothing records in the late 8-10 Log 85-16

Saturday the 25

born with fine weather & steering by the wind S 40 E under all sail at 6 P.M. wire ship 8 A.M. Middle Part ditto. latter Part backed to S 40 E saw blackfish so end in the late 8-17 Log 82-40

November the 26-1857

born with moderate gale from SE & steering by the wind S 50 E under all sail Middle & latter Part ditto backed ship to 8 latter Part ditto saw nothing records in the late 7-50 Log 82-10 30

Sunday the 27

born with moderate gale from SE & steering by the wind S 40 E under all sail Middle & latter Part ditto saw nothing record in the late 8-17 Log 85 34

Monday the 28

born with moderate gale from SE & steering by the wind S 40 E under all sail employed in stowing down oil in the after hold middle and latter Part fire so end in the late 9-40 Log 87-20 30

Tuesday the 29

born with fine weather wind at 5 P.M. steering by the wind S 40 E under all sail middle & latter Part ditto saw black fish record in the late 11-10 Log 84-30

Wednesday the 30

born with fine weather wind at 10 & steering by the wind S 40 E under all sail middle ditto saw blackfish so end in the late 12-53 Log 86-30
