December the 20-1857
 born with fine weather stowing by the wind
 P.M. under all sail saw blackfish lowered
 & caught one middle & latter part fine
 employed in repairing the flying jib
 & mizen top of sail & ends
 in the late 12-40 by 85-52

Thursday the 21

born with fine weather wind at 85° stowing
 by the wind P.M. under all sail middle &
 latter part fine saw nothing & ends 85-57
 in the late 12-11 by 85-57

Friday the 22

born with fine weather wind at 85° stowing
 by the wind under all sail middle latter part
 latter part spoke the house 14 months
 out for a boiling in the late 12-46 by
 86-20

Saturday the 23

born with fine weather wind at 85° stowing
 by the wind under all sail middle & latter part
 employed in stowing down oil in the fore hold
 & ends in the late 13-57 by 86-30

Sunday the 24

born with calm finished stowing down
 out middle & latter part fine saw finbacks & ends
 in the late 14-17 by 86-22

Remarks Onboard

December the 25-1857
 born with fine weather wind at 85° and stowing
 by the wind under all sail at 4 P.M. took stage
 to N.E. Middle & latter part latter employed in
 repairing a boat saw blackfish lowered &
 caught 5 & got the seaward boat & ends
 in the late 13-47 by 86

Tuesday the 25

born with fine weather wind at 85° stowing
 by the wind P.M. under all sail middle &
 latter part latter saw blackfish employed in
 repairing a boat & painting a boat
 in the late 13-21 by 86-25

Wednesday the 27

born with fine weather wind at 58° & stowing
 by the wind P.M. under all sail Middle & latter
 fine latter part saw sperm whales lowered
 & chased in ends late 12-55 by 81-15

Thursday the 28

born with fine weather employed in chasing
 Whales at 1 P.M. struck 2 boats & caught 2
 took them to the ship and built in one &
 by other all night & at day light
 commenced cutting & at 10 A.M. finished
 broad forward to 55° saw a sail & ends
 in the late 12-45 by 85-40
