December the 29

born with fine weather & spoke the
Washington of Sanlucho at
17 months out 700 and at 2 PM commenced
hoisting Middle & latter part fine were ship
to SSW so ends in the late 13-10

Friday the 30

born with strong gale from SSE at sundown
more ship in shore SSE under all sail a hoisting
middle part with latter part finished hoisting
were ship to SSW near a sail so ends
in the late 13-10

birth day Sunday the 31st 22 years
born with moderate gale from SE steering by
the wind SSW at 4 PM spoke the
Marcella of New Bedford 19 months out
200 middle & latter part fine so ends
in the late 13-41

January the 1st 1848

born on the fine of pleasure & weather wind at
SE steering by the wind SE under all sail
middle & latter part with on board the main top
of sail & bent the mace one employed in
repairing at boat sounds in the late 12-24

Tuesday the 2

born with fine weather wind at SE steering
by the wind SE under all sail middle &
latter part fine saw nothing so ends
in the late 12-59

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January the 3-1848

born with fine weather were ship to SSW
under all sail spoke the last fine latter part
were ship to SE saw nothing employed in
repairing a boat sounds in the late 13-04

Thursday the 4

born with fine weather wind at SE steering
by the wind SE under all sail at 6 PM took
in top & sails middle & latter part with
saw 2 ships so ends in the late 12-19

Friday the 5

born with fine weather & steering by the
wind SE at 4 PM were ship to SSW
middle and latter part fine employed in
steering down of sail in the fore hold so ends
in the late 12-48

Saturday the 6

born with fine weather & steering by the
wind under all sail finished steering down
and at 4 PM spoke the Washington 750
lbs. & the Henry with 200 lbs the
Edward Quernel with 1750 mibls and
latter part with steering by the wind SE
under all sail so ends in the late 12-24
