January the 27th 1898
 born with foggy weather wind at S E &
 steering by the wind S by W under all sail
 middle part fine latter part duller saw
 the schooner so ends in the late 10-30 Lpd
 80-12

Sunday the 28th
 born with light wind from S S E &
 steering by the wind S by W under all sail
 Middle part fine latter part saw sperm
 whales however & the starboard boat
 & went out & struck & got a took them
 to the ship the West boat & stove

Monday the 29th
 born with fine weather employed in
 cutting and at 5 P.M. took the other
 whale to the ship lowered & struck
 another & the latter end of the dark
 finished cutting in one & by by the
 other all night at daylight began
 cutting the other so ends in the late
 10-50 Lpd 81-38

Tuesday the 30th
 born with fine weather & at 2 P.M.
 finished cutting lowered forward by the
 wind S under easy sail at 5 P.M. commenced
 hoisting Middle part squally latter part
 rather saw sperm whales however but all
 in vain so ends in the late
 10-50 Lpd 81-50

Ship Edward Duesmel

January the 31st 1898
 born with light winds from S E and at
 meridian lowered after saw a whale
 brought & took them to the ship called
 them & by by them all night employed
 in hoisting middle & latter part still saw
 blackfish so ends in the late 11-15
 Lpd 81-20

February the 1st 1898
 born with fine weather employed
 in hoisting & at 4 P.M. cut in one whale
 body & by by the other whole & head
 middle & latter part fine still &
 hoisting saw nothing so ends in the
 late 11-20 Lpd 81-30

Wednesday the 2nd
 born with fine weather & at 1 P.M.
 commenced cutting the other whale & at dusk
 finished & by by the head all night
 middle & latter part fine still & hoisting
 saw & breach so ends in the late 10-50 Lpd
 81-00

Thursday the 3rd
 commenced with fine weather cut in the
 other head & braced forward by the wind
 E N E under easy sail & hoisting Middle &
 latter part raining at 2 A.M. finished
 hoisting saw & sail so ends in the late 10-40
 Lpd 81-00
