February the 21-1838

bon with light winds & calm steering by the wind NNE under all sail employed in carrying down rigging & at 4 PM were ship to S middle & latter part fine saw blackish finches carrying down as ends in the late 10-53-54 89-90 74

Thursday the 22

bon with Moderate gales from SE & steering by the wind SSE under all sail middle & latter part little saw nothing employed in repairing a boat as ends in the late 12-00-54 89-90 74

Friday the 23

bon with Moderate gales from SE and by the wind SSE under all sail at 2 PM were ship & steered N by E middle & latter part little saw nothing employed in repairing a boat in the late 11-30-54 89-90 74

Saturday the 24

bon with moderate gales & light show from E steering N by E under all sail middle & latter part being saw nothing as ends in the late 9-17-54

Sunday the 25-

bon with light winds & calm & saw blackish hovers & caught 2 took them to the ship middle & being as ends in the late 8-18-54 89-90 74

Ship Edward Doesnel 75

February the 26-1838

bon with light winds & calm steering by the wind NNE under all sail middle & latter part fine saw nothing as ends in the late 7-45-54 89-90 75

Wednesday the 27

bon with calm & light winds from SE & steering by the wind SSE under all sail saw nothing as ends in the late 7-00-54 89-90 75

Thursday the 28

bon with light winds from SE & steering by the wind SSE under all sail at 4 PM were ship to SSE middle part fine latter part turned to S as ends in the late 7-05-54 89-90 75

March the 1-1838

bon with light winds from ENE and steering by the wind NNE under all sail middle part fine latter part heading NNE saw nothing as ends in the late 6-03-54 89-90 75

Friday the 2

bon with fine weather wind at 8 PM steering by the wind SSE under all sail middle & latter part little saw nothing as ends in the late 4-50-54 89-90 75
