

Remarks Onboard

March the 3-1838
 ran with fine weather wind at SSE
 steering by the wind & under all sail at
 4 P.M. saw Crystal head bearing SSE
 distance 30 miles middle & latter part
 fine steering in for point at meridian
 sent in a boat & spoke the Masson of
 New Bedford 4 months old 40 bbl of oil
 or ends in the lot 5-36

Sunday the 4
 ran with fine weather lying off &
 on at Crystal at 5 P.M. the boat
 came off made sail in company with
 the Masson latter part saw blackfish
 however and caught 2 or ends in the lot
 4-38

Monday the 5
 ran with fine weather & steering by the
 wind W by N under all sail middle part
 fine latter part employed in repairing
 the main or mill saw nothing seen
 in the lot 4-13 Log 81-30 W

Tuesday the 6
 ran with light winds from SSE
 head steering W by N under all
 sail shifted the fore topsail & main
 topsail & latter part fine
 employed in mending sails sent the
 seven topsail main top & sail & fore sail
 saw black fish seeds in the 5-38
 Log 83-35

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March the 7-1838
 ran with fine weather & calm saw black
 fish however & caught 3 & 4 bbl of oil
 by abash latter part light wind saw
 sperm whales however & chased but all
 in vain no ends in the lot 20 or 30 bbl of oil

Thursday the 8
 ran with light wind and calm saw
 black fish middle & latter part all
 calm saw few black fish seeds in the lot
 2-41 Log 84-30

Friday the 9
 ran with light winds & equally
 from W steering SSE under all sail
 middle & latter part little seen
 in the lot 3-41 Log 85-55

Saturday the 10
 ran with light winds from SSE & steering
 SSE by S under all sail middle part spoke
 the bark Minerva 20 months old 5 or
 10 ends in the lot 5-22 Log 85-22 W

Sunday the 11
 commenced with winds & calm steered
 SSE under all sail middle part wore ship
 to SSE latter part little saw nothing seen
 in the lot 5-12 Log 87
