

Remarks Onboard

March the 12 1838
 Run with light winds from S & steering by the wind & under all sail Middle & latter Part ditto employed in repairing sails & shifted the foreboard about 20 ends in the late 2-50 1/2

Thursday the 13

Run with light winds from S & caught one black fish took him to the ship & middle Part steering S & by S under all sail latter Part ditto saw nothing out but main sail employed in repairing it so and in the late 2-14 1/2 51-30 1/2

Wednesday the 14

Run with light winds & steering S & by S under all sail Middle Part fine latter Part saw pt of Sclua Bearing E Dist 9 miles & saw black fish caught & took them to the ship & so ends in the late 2-10 1/2

Thursday the 15

Run with fine weather saw black fish & caught 2 & took them to the ship & wore ship to S & by S of shore middle & latter Part ditto saw nothing employed in boiling so ends in the late 1-5 1/2 51-38

Remarks Onboard

March the 16 1838
 Run with light winds from W & steering by the wind S & by S under all sail at 5 PM wore ship to S & by S Middle & latter Part heading S & by S saw nothing but the main sail & employed in mending sails so ends in the late 1-52 1/2 51-0 1/2

Saturday the 17

Run with fine weather wind at 5 PM steering by the wind S & by S under all sail Middle & latter Part ditto lowered after black fish caught & took them to the ship so ends in the late 2-55 1/2 51 1/2

Sunday the 18

Run with calm Middle and latter Part ditto saw the land so ends in the late 2-17

Monday the 19

Run with light winds from S & steering E for timber under all sail and at 7 PM came to anchor in 12 fathoms water & at 9:10 AM took our anchor and anchored in timber in 6 fathoms water with the foreboard anchor down so and in timber
