March the 20 1838
 born with fine weather took of a
 log & loads of wood middle & latter
 Part fine took of a raft of water
 so ends

Wednesday the 21
 born with fine weather employed in
 cutting wood middle & latter Part fine
 so ends

Thursday the 22
 born with fine weather employed in
 wooding middle & latter Part little got
 of 2 loads of wood so ends

Friday the 23
 born with fine weather at 1 PM
 James Gifford John coral & Henry
 Hartford came aft Clinched the
 Captain Mate & Second Mate &
 struck them & by fighting got clear
 & put them in Irons no others
 interfeared so ends

Saturday the 24
 born with fine weather middle & latter
 Part little employed in wooding took so
 loads of water so ends

Remarks Onboard

March the 25-1838
 born with fine weather and left Henry
 Hartford on shore middle Part raining
 latter Part fine took him off again
 at 10 AM took our anchor made all
 sail hauled the wind SSW so ends

Monday the 26
 born with fine weather wind at SSW
 steering by the wind SSE under all sail
 at 4 PM took a ship of shore at 6 PM
 took to SSE & at 7 PM took of shore
 at day light took 3 in shore latter Part
 steered SSW & at 8 PM spoke a brig
 bound to Smyrna so ends Late 3-45

Tuesday the 27
 born with fine weather wind at SSW &
 steering by the wind SSE under all sail
 at 6 PM took of shore WNW & middle
 Part little at meridian took in shore
 latter Part calm so ends in the
 Late 4-9

Wednesday the 28
 born with light wind from SSE steering
 by the wind S under all sail middle Part
 fine took a ship of shore S and at 10 AM
 took ship in shore so ends in the late
 4-51-
