under all sail at 8 PM came to anchor
in Cayta with the barboard anchor
down & 60 fathoms of chain middle
& latter part fine one watch on shore

Friday the 30

born with fine weather one watch on shore
employed in blacking the hands middle
& latter part ditto so ends in Cayta all well

Saturday the 31 no letters

born with fine weather & the helvation
came in to anchor to day with
230 lbs of oil 5 months out middle &
latter part ditto so end one watch on shore

April the 1 1898

born with fine weather employed in ships
duty one watch on shore middle and
latter part fine all well

Monday the 2

born with fine weather middle & latter
part ditto one watch on shore the ship
Chavara came in to anchor with
60 lbs of oil 5 months out no letters
for me

born with fine weather employed in
ships duty middle & latter part
ditto so ends one watch on shore

Wednesday the 4

born with fine weather employed
in ships duty middle & latter part
ditto so ends in Cayta one watch
on shore

Thursday the 5

born with fine weather all hands on
board Ready for sea middle & latter
part ditto at 10 AM have short
got under way made all sail &
haul? the wind W by N so ends
all well Ltd 5-06

Friday the 6

born with fine weather under all sail
steering by the wind W by N at 2 PM
tacked ship in shore took in fore &
mizen tops & sail & flying jib
at 6 tacked ship of shore & by 5 middle
& latter part headed S.W. saw nothing
so ends in the Lute 5-37 Ltd 82

Saturday the 7 1898

born with fine weather wind at 5 PM
steering by the wind S.W. under all sail
at 5 PM saw a sail & black fish
middle & latter part fine so ends in
the Lute 6-46 Ltd 89-5-0 W
