

Remarks Onboard

April the 17 1898

born with light winds & steering
W by N under all sail middle &
latter Port ditto at daylight saw
heads of islands bearing N by W distance
about 20 miles so ends in the lat 19° 5'

Wednesday the 18

born with light winds steering for head
Island middle Port fine at 6 AM
sent in 2 boats after turpin and got
the old boat stove and lost the boat
anchor and got about 45 turpin
so ends in the lat of head Island

Thursday the 19

born with light winds at 6 AM the
boats came up & hauled the wind ESE
middle & latter Port much the same
could not fetch the island so ends
in the lat 1-41-40 99-40

Friday the 20th

born with light & steering N by W under
all sail down by Charles Island middle
and latter fine saw Harrington Island
so ends in the lat 1-15 91-00 W

Remarks Onboard

April the 21 1898

born with light winds heading W by N
under all sail middle and latter Port
calm so ends in the lat 1-06 91-39

Sunday the 22

born with light ESE wind from 8-18
steering N by W under all sail middle
Port calm latter Port ditto we are
forming lee bay where the whales
are so thick but not so damaged as
a one in three have no ships so ends
in the lat 15 miles south 91-39

Monday the 23

born with light wind from N by W
& steering by the wind under all sail
bound to James Island middle & latter
Port light winds from N by W & steering
E for Clarence Island so ends in the
lat 12 miles N 91-28

Tuesday the 24

born with light winds and calm &
a strong current setting N by W
wind at 4 PM steering East under all sail
middle Port calm saw black fish hound
& caught & took them to ship so ends
in the lat 22 miles N
