& steering by the wind SE under all
sail middle part fine latter saw
finbacks no ends in the late 1-40 10
540 87.45

Thursday the 3

bon with fine weather wind at SE
& steering by the wind SE under all
sail middle & latter the same saw
nothing no ends in the late 38 miles

Friday the 4

bon with fine weather wind at SE and
steering by the wind SE under all sail
middle part fine at 8 P.M. saw sperm
whales lowered & shared but all in vain
no ends in the late 9 miles 5
