

Remarks Onboard

May the 24 - 1838

Comm with fine weather wind at S & steering
by the wind & under all sail at 4 AM about
the job middle & latter part fine
employed in repairing sails so ends
in the late 1-15 N by 85-92

Friday the 25

fine weather wind at S & by the
wind & by S under all sail middle &
latter part much the same saw nothing
so ends in the late 1-30 N by 84-90

Saturday the 26

commenced with fine weather wind at S
steering by the wind & S & under all sail
middle & latter fine saw a sail so end
in the late 50 miles north

Sunday the 27

Comm with fine weather wind at S steering
by the wind & S & under all sail at 9
AM spoke the Frances of New Bedford
with 1450 bbls oil 24 months out middle
last calm latter part light winds from
S heading S & S 10 ends in the late 50 miles

Monday the 28

Comm with fine weather wind at S steering
by the wind & S & under all sail middle
& latter part ditto saw a sail to leeward
so ends in the late 9 miles S by 81-85

Remarks Onboard

May the 29 - 1838

Comm with fine weather wind at S &
steering by the wind & S & under all sail
middle & latter part ditto at 10 AM
near the land & a brig so ends in the
late 44 miles south

Tuesday the 30

Comm with strong trade from S & S by
steering by the wind & S & under all
sail at 2 PM tacked ship off shore
at 4 tacked in shore at 4 tacked off
& at 4 tacked in at 4 tacked off
at day light tacked in shore so end
in the late 55 miles south

Wednesday the 31

Comm with fine weather at meridian
tacked in shore at 4 PM saw a sperm
whaler lowered & chased but all in vain
middle part fine latter part saw
humpbacks lowered & chased so not get
any so ends in the late 1-10 south

June the 1 1838

Comm with fine weather wind at S &
& at meridian tacked in shore under all
sail middle part calm latter part light
winds from S & S by 80 saw killers
lowered & caught one took him to the
ship so ends in the late 1-24 S
